- ☐ Have you installed MS SQL Server 2016 SP1 v. 13.0.4001.0?
- ☐ Have you activated your MS SQL Server software?
- ☐ Have you enabled the mixed authentication mode on your MS SQL Server software?
- ☐ Have you ensured that only local users are used?
- ☐ Does your SQL server listens to connections on a statically-assigned TCP port?
- ☐ Does your database reside in a separate network segment?
- ☐ Does your MS SQL server features DB Engine?
- ☐ Have you set the SQL_Latin1_General_CP1_CI_AS server-level collation?
- ☐ Have you set the database-level collation?
- ☐ Have you ensured that you use only the following special characters for your database passwords for monitoring and analytics: @#^*():.,;>[]<>/ ?
- ☐ Have you created the following MS SQL logins in your database:
 - ☐ mssql_dba_user: "wf_dba"
 - ☐ mssql_ct_user: "workfusion"
 - ☐ mssql_ws_user: "workspace"
 - ☐ mssql_sqc_user: "sqc"
 - ☐ mssql_ds_user: "ds"
 - ☐ mssql_rpa_user: "rpa"
 - ☐ mssql_pm_user: "pm"
 - ☐ mssql_ocr_user: "ocr"
 - ☐ mssql_dm_user: "dm"
 - ☐ mssql_rapi_user: "rapi"
 - ☐ mssql_automl_mms_user: "automl_mms"
- ☐ Have you provided **mssql_dba_user** with the **db_owner** permissions?

Additional requirements for the high-availability mode

- ☐ Have you configured Windows clustering to setup the SQL clustering in the Always-on mode?
- ☐ Have you created your database under Always-on Active-Active cluster?
- ☐ Have you configured the database with a static AG listener?
- ☐ Have you set the asynchronous replication between the primary and the secondary replicas?
